AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING FOR DUAL LANGUAGE SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to provide funding to
- 2 support dual language schools as interdistrict magnet school programs
- 3 or as part of the state-wide interdistrict public school attendance
- 4 program.
