AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR OPERATIONAL GROWTH AND EXPENSES OF THE NAUGATUCK VALLEY WATERBURY BRANCH LINE OF THE METRO-NORTH COMMUTER RAILROAD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate six
- 4 million dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the Department

5 of Transportation for the purpose of ensuring the operational growth of

7 Branch Line of the Metro-North Commuter Railroad.
