AN ACT CONCERNING ACCESSIBILITY OF MEDICAL DIAGNOSTIC EQUIPMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Commissioner
- 2 of Public Health to adopt regulations requiring each health care facility
- 3 to meet or exceed the technical standards for accessibility developed
- 4 by the federal Architectural and Transportation Barriers Compliance
- 5 Board in accordance with Section 4203 of the Patient Protection and
- 6 Affordable Care Act, P.L. 111-148, as amended from time to time, for
- 7 medical diagnostic equipment.

Statement of Purpose:

To require medical diagnostic equipment purchased by health care facilities to meet technical standards for accessibility by persons with disabilities.
