AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PURPLE ALERT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1	That the general statutes be amended to establish a purple alert
2	system to provide alerts about a missing person who (1) has a mental or
3	cognitive disability that is not Alzheimer's disease or a dementia-related
4	disorder, has an intellectual disability or a developmental disability, has
5	a brain injury, has another physical, mental or emotional disability that
6	is not related to substance abuse or has a combination of any of such
7	disabilities or injuries; (2) disappeared under circumstances indicating
8	a credible threat of immediate danger or serious bodily harm to the
9	person, as determined by a local law enforcement agency; (3) cannot be
10	returned to safety without law enforcement intervention; and (4) does
11	not meet the criteria for issuance of an alert under another alert system.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a purple alert system to help locate certain missing persons.
