AN ACT PREVENTING WRONG-WAY DRIVERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of Transportation to (1) install wrong-way signs with actuated flashers on all highway exit ramps and other locations throughout the state that have a high risk for wrong-way driving, (2) install monitoring devices at such ramps and locations that will notify a law enforcement agency when such flashers are activated, and (3) install wrong-way signs with actuated flashers that utilize solar power where practicable.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase road safety and prevent wrong-way drivers.
