AN ACT ESTABLISHING A REFUNDABLE CREDIT AGAINST THE PERSONAL INCOME TAX FOR RENTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 12 of the general statutes be amended to establish a
- 2 refundable credit against the personal income tax in the amount of fifty
- 3 per cent of the rent paid by an individual for a taxable year for a primary
- 4 residence in the state or three thousand dollars, whichever is less.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a refundable credit against the personal income tax for renters.
