**AN ACT CONCERNING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF TRAFFIC AND PEDESTRIAN SAFETY MEASURES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 242 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Department of Transportation to study, design and implement traffic
- 3 and pedestrian safety measures that include, but need not be limited to,
- 4 flashing signs and signals, elevated crosswalks, three-dimensional
- 5 crosswalks and automated traffic enforcement safety devices to enforce
- 6 the provisions of section 14-299 of the general statutes.
