**AN ACT CONCERNING NOTATIONS IN LAW ENFORCEMENT
DATABASES REGARDING PEOPLE WHO MAY INADVERTENTLY
RESPOND INAPPROPRIATELY TO COMMANDS FROM LAW
ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to permit police dispatching
- 2 systems and the Connecticut On-Line Law Enforcement
- 3 Communications Teleprocessing System to include an indication that an
- 4 individual in a household may inadvertently respond inappropriately
- 5 to commands from law enforcement officers due to physical, emotional
- 6 or developmental reasons, at the request of a person in the same
- 7 household.

Statement of Purpose:

To help prevent misunderstandings in interactions with law enforcement officers that may result in the use of force.
