AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROCESS AND TIMELINE FOR THE REVIEW OF EXISTING REGULATIONS OF CONNECTICUT STATE AGENCIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That section 4-189i of the general statutes be amended to require all agencies to (1) review their existing regulations and determine which of such regulations are obsolete, inconsistent or ineffective not later than June 30, 2026, (2) submit the agency's review of its regulations to the applicable committee of cognizance not later than January 1, 2026, for a public hearing to be held during the regular session, and (3) include the status of the agency's review process on the eRegulations system.

Statement of Purpose:

To make modifications to the process for reviewing agency regulations to determine whether they are obsolete, inconsistent or ineffective and change the deadlines for such review.
