AN ACT REGULATING ACCESSIBILITY AND COSTS OF HEALTH CARE IN THIS STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to: (1) Increase Medicaid
- 2 reimbursement rates; (2) regulate medical debt; (3) regulate pharmacy
- 3 benefits management practices; (4) conduct a study of, and provide
- 4 consumers access to, the impact of vertical integration in the health care
- 5 system in this state; (5) limit the use of prior authorization practices; and
- 6 (6) regulate private equity acquisition of hospitals and medical care
- 7 centers.

Statement of Purpose:

To: (1) Increase Medicaid reimbursement rates; (2) regulate medical debt; (3) regulate pharmacy benefits management practices; (4) conduct a study of, and provide consumers access to, the impact of vertical integration in the health care system in this state; (5) limit the use of prior authorization practices; and (6) regulate private equity acquisition of hospitals and medical care centers.
