AN ACT CONCERNING THE SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF CULTURALLY-RESPONSIVE TEACHING PRACTICES PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF TEACHER CERTIFICATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 166 of the general statutes be amended to require that
- 2 applicants for an initial educator certificate successfully complete
- 3 courses in culturally-responsive teaching practices prior to being
- 4 issued professional certification.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that applicants for teacher certification to successfully complete courses in culturally-responsive teaching practices prior to being issued certification.

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
