AN ACT CONCERNING FREEDOM OF EXPRESSION AND OF THE PRESS FOR STUDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That titles 10 and 10a of the general statutes be amended to provide 2 students attending public schools, colleges and universities in this state 3 with the right to exercise freedom of speech and of assembly, and that 4 such exercise or the expression of a student's religious or political 5 viewpoints shall be free from discrimination or penalty based on the religious or political content of such expression, provided such 6 expression is not obscene as to minors, is libelous or slanderous or 8 incites students as to create a clear and present danger of the 9 commission of unlawful acts, the violation of school regulations or the 10 material and substantial disruption of the orderly operation of the 11 school.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect student expression and student publications except when such expression or publications are obscene, libelous, slanderous or disrupt school activities.
