**AN ACT ESTABLISHING PROFICIENCY EXAMINATIONS AND A  
PUBLIC SCHOOL VOUCHER PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) require each local or
- 2 regional board of education to administer a grade-level proficiency
- 3 examination in reading, writing and math to each student as a condition
- 4 to elevating such student to the next grade level or allowing such
- 5 student to graduate, and (2) allow the parent or guardian of any student
- 6 who attends a public school in which less than sixty per cent of students
- 7 pass such grade-level proficiency examinations to obtain a voucher to
- 8 enroll such child in a public school within the same or an adjoining
- 9 school district.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To (1) require administration of a grade-level proficiency examination as a condition to elevating a student to the next grade level or allowing a student to graduate, and (2) allow the parent or guardian of a student who attends a school in which less than sixty per cent of students pass such grade-level proficiency examinations to obtain a voucher to enroll such child in a public school within the same or adjoining school district.
