AN ACT CONCERNING QUALIFICATIONS FOR EMPLOYMENT AS AN ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to disqualify any person from
- 2 employment as an animal control officer who is convicted of animal
- 3 abuse or neglect, or who enters a plea of nolo contendere or into a plea
- 4 bargain concerning a charge of animal abuse or neglect pursuant to
- 5 section 53-247 of the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that animal control officers are morally capable of adhering to a strict standard of care for animals in their possession.
