AN ACT CONCERNING BLACK BEAR CONSERVATION AND THE REDUCTION OF PERSON TO BEAR CONFLICTS AND PREDATION OF WHITE-TAILED DEER BY BLACK BEARS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of
- 2 Energy and Environmental Protection, within available resources, to
- 3 enact measures to promote black bear conservation, reduce human-bear
- 4 conflict and to reduce predation of white-tailed deer fawns by black
- 5 bears.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide for protections from black bear predation of white-tailed deer fawns and reduce human-bear conflicts through certain conservation measures.
