AN ACT CONCERNING MUNICIPAL LIABILITY WHEN PROVIDING PUBLIC ACCESS TO RECREATIONAL AREAS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 925 of general statutes be amended to provide that: (1)
- 2 A municipality that operates a dog park shall be immune from liability
- 3 for any action that resulted from injury to property or person unless
- 4 the injury was proximately caused by the negligence of the
- 5 municipality for failure to guard or warn against a dangerous
- 6 condition, use, structure or activity, and (2) any person engaged in a
- 7 recreational activity at a bike park shall assume the risk and legal
- 8 responsibility for any injury to person or property arising out of the
- 9 hazards inherent with the activity, unless the injury was proximately
- 10 caused by the negligence of the municipality for failure to guard or
- 11 warn against a dangerous condition, use or structure.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce municipal liability for certain activities that are inherently dangerous.
