## AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO STUDY CONVERTING BIOSOLIDS INTO ENERGY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established a task force
- 2 to study allowing municipalities to convert biosolids into energy
- 3 through the process of anaerobic digestion. Such study shall include,
- 4 but need not be limited to, an evaluation of (1) existing infrastructure
- 5 that could be used to convert biosolids into energy, (2) any new
- 6 infrastructure that would be needed to convert biosolids into energy,
- 7 and (3) any legislative changes that would be needed to enable
- 8 municipalities to convert biosolids into energy.
- 9 (b) The task force shall consist of the following members:
- 10 (1) Two appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives,
- 11 one of whom shall have expertise in the management of biosolids and
- 12 one of whom shall have expertise in anaerobic digestion;
- 13 (2) Two appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate;
- 14 (3) One appointed by the majority leader of the House of

- 15 Representatives;
- 16 (4) One appointed by the majority leader of the Senate;
- 17 (5) One appointed by the minority leader of the House of 18 Representatives;
- 19 (6) One appointed by the minority leader of the Senate;
- 20 (7) The Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection, or 21 the commissioner's designee; and
- 22 (8) The chairperson of the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority, or 23 the chairperson's designee.
- 24 (c) Any member of the task force appointed under subdivision (1),
- 25 (2), (3), (4), (5) or (6) of subsection (b) of this section may be a member
- of the General Assembly.
- 27 (d) All initial appointments to the task force shall be made not later
- 28 than thirty days after the effective date of this section. Any vacancy
- 29 shall be filled by the appointing authority.
- 30 (e) The speaker of the House of Representatives and the president
- 31 pro tempore of the Senate shall select the chairpersons of the task force
- 32 from among the members of the task force. Such chairpersons shall
- 33 schedule the first meeting of the task force, which shall be held not
- 34 later than sixty days after the effective date of this section.
- 35 (f) The administrative staff of the joint standing committee of the
- 36 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to energy and
- 37 technology shall serve as administrative staff of the task force.
- 38 (g) Not later than February 1, 2024, the task force shall submit a
- 39 report on its findings and recommendations to the joint standing
- 40 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
- 41 relating to energy and technology, in accordance with the provisions of
- 42 section 11-4a of the general statutes. The task force shall terminate on

- 43 the date that it submits such report or February 1, 2024, whichever is
- 44 later.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
