AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER PROTECTION AND REVISIONS TO THE LIQUOR CONTROL ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective January 1, 2022*) The Commissioner of
2 Consumer Protection shall study the types of current alcoholic liquor
3 permits and the need for such permits and shall submit a report in
4 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,
5 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
6 cognizance of matters relating to general law. Such report shall include
7 the commissioner's recommendations, if any, regarding amendments to
8 the Liquor Control Act.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
