AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER PROTECTION AND REVISIONS TO THE LIQUOR CONTROL ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective January 1, 2022) The Commissioner of
- 2 Consumer Protection shall study the types of current alcoholic liquor
- 3 permits and the need for such permits and shall submit a report in
- 4 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,
- 5 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
- 6 cognizance of matters relating to general law. Such report shall include
- 7 the commissioner's recommendations, if any, regarding amendments to
- 8 the Liquor Control Act.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1 January 1, 2022 New section
