AN ACT REQUIRING A PLAN FOR THE TRANSLATION AND REVIEW OF ALL FORMS AND APPLICATIONS REQUIRED TO ACCESS STATE AGENCY SERVICES OR BENEFITS BY LIMITED-ENGLISH PROFICIENT INDIVIDUALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require (1) the Commissioner 2

of Administrative Services to develop a plan for the review and

3 translation of all printed or electronic forms or applications required to

4 access state agency services or benefits, including, but not limited to,

5 forms or applications necessary to access vital records or to obtain

identification documents such as a driver's license, into the twelve most

7 common non-English languages spoken by limited-English proficient 8 individuals in the state based on the data in the most recent American

9 Community Survey published by the United States Census Bureau and

10 to update such plan every two years, (2) all state agencies to adopt and

11 implement such plan and update such plan every two years, and (3) all

12 state agencies to designate a language access coordinator to work with

- 13 the Department of Administrative Services to ensure compliance with
- 14 such plan.

Statement of Purpose:

To require (1) the Commissioner of Administrative Services to develop a plan for the translation and review of certain forms and applications into languages spoken by limited-English proficient individuals in the state, and (2) state agencies to adopt and implement such plan.
