Public Act No. 23-6

AN ACT CONCERNING CERTAIN HARVESTING OF HORSESHOE CRABS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2023*) (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of title 26 of the general statutes, no person shall engage in the hand-harvesting of horseshoe crabs or the eggs of horseshoe crabs from the waters of this state.

- (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a) of this section, the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection may authorize the hand-harvesting of horseshoe crabs by permit for educational or scientific purposes provided the commissioner determines that such harvesting will not cause harm to the horseshoe crab population in this state.
- (c) Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be fined twenty-five dollars for each specimen taken in violation of this section.
- (d) The Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection shall enforce the provisions of this section.
