AN ACT CONCERNING DOG LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 22-338 of the general statutes be amended to require any
- 2 dog of the age of six months or older be licensed every three years in the
- town clerk's office in the town where such dog is kept.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce municipal administrative burdens in the annual issuance of dog licenses.
