***AN ACT PROHIBITING CONSIDERATION OF CERTAIN STUDIES
DURING PERMITTING AND APPROVAL PROCESSES.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit the state or
- 2 municipalities from considering any study concerning environmental,
- 3 health, traffic or economic impacts produced in a permitting or project
- 4 approval process, unless the party submitting such study discloses (1)
- 5 the author of the study, (2) the entity that will pay for the work in
- 6 question, (3) the cost of the study, and (4) any conflict of interest.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit the state or municipalities from considering any study concerning environmental, health, traffic or economic impacts produced in a permitting or project approval process, unless the party submitting such study discloses certain information.
