AN ACT REQUIRING CONTINUING EDUCATION FOR LICENSED HAIR STYLISTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require a hair stylist to
- 2 complete a certain number of hours of continuing education at a
- 3 centrally located product manufacturer, hairstyling school or reputable
- 4 salon in the state approved by the Commissioner of Public Health
- 5 before being eligible to renew his or her license.

Statement of Purpose:

To require continuing education for licensed hair stylists.
