

Substitute Bill No. 6556

AN ACT CONCERNING THE ONLINE PUBLICATION OF LEGAL NOTICES BY MUNICIPALITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- Section 1. Section 1-2 of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2023*):
- Each provision of the general statutes, the special acts or the charter
- 4 of any town, city or borough which requires the insertion of an
- 5 advertisement of a legal notice in a daily newspaper shall be construed
- 6 to permit such advertisement to be inserted in a weekly newspaper <u>or</u>,
- 7 if such provision applies to a town, city or borough, posted in a
- 8 <u>conspicuous place on the Internet web site of the town, city or</u>
- 9 borough, provided that any such notice posted on an Internet web site
- 10 <u>shall include the date and time that such notice was posted;</u> but this
- 11 section shall not be construed to reduce or otherwise affect the time
- 12 required by law for giving such notice. Whenever notice of any action
- or other proceeding is required to be given by publication in a
- 14 newspaper, either by statute or order of court, the newspaper selected
- 15 for that purpose, unless otherwise expressly prescribed, shall be one
- 16 having a substantial circulation in the town in which at least one of the
- 17 parties, for whose benefit such notice is given, resides.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
