AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS TO COMMUNICATE ANY SAFETY PLAN PRESCRIBED TO A MINOR PATIENT UPON DISCHARGE WITH SUCH MINOR PATIENT'S SCHOOL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require each hospital and
- 2 emergency psychiatric health care provider that prescribes a safety plan
- 3 to a minor patient upon discharge to communicate, with the consent of
- 4 such minor patient's parent or legal guardian, such safety plan with the
- 5 minor patient's school.

Statement of Purpose:

To promote student safety at schools by requiring hospitals and emergency psychiatric health care providers to communicate any safety plan prescribed to a minor patient with such minor patient's school.

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
