AN ACT PROHIBITING THE DISCRIMINATION OF A PERSON BASED UPON WHETHER SUCH PERSON WEARS A SURGICAL MASK, HAS BEEN ADMINISTERED A COVID-19 VACCINE OR HAS BEEN TESTED FOR COVID-19.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit a business or other
- 2 entity that receives state funding from discriminating against any
- 3 person based upon whether such person wears a surgical mask, has
- 4 been administered a COVID-19 vaccine or been tested for COVID-19.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit a business or other entity that receives state funding from discriminating against any person based upon whether such person wears a surgical mask, has been administered a COVID-19 vaccine or been tested COVID-19.
