***AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONNECTICUT PORT AUTHORITY.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 15-31i of the general statutes is  
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October*  
3 *1, 2023*):

4 (c) The authority shall further do [all acts and things] whatever is  
5 necessary [by] in accordance with federal or state law, rule or regulation  
6 or relevant contractual requirements to effect the lease, assignment or  
7 transfer of ownership, jurisdiction or authority to control, operate and  
8 maintain the ports and harbors of the state in the manner deemed by the  
9 authority to be in its best interests, whether by deed, lease, management  
10 contract, agency agreement, assignment or assumption, all to the extent  
11 contemplated by such memoranda of understanding. The Department  
12 of Transportation shall receive no compensation in consideration of any  
13 such [leases, assignments or transfers] lease, assignment or transfer.  
14 Upon satisfaction of all such requirements, the authority, from time to  
15 time, shall notify the Department of Transportation of its readiness to

16 accept any such [leases, assignments or transfers] lease, assignment or  
17 transfer with respect to the ports and harbors of the state and all  
18 documents and contracts necessary to effect such [leases, assignments  
19 or transfers] lease, assignment or transfer shall be executed.
