AN ACT ALLOWING A TOWN TO DESIGNATE ITSELF A CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 7-101 of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2025*):
- 3 (a) A town may, by vote of its legislative body, designate itself a city.
- 4 (b) Each town or city shall provide itself with a seal with the name of
- 5 the town or city and the state and the word "seal" inscribed thereon and
- 6 may place thereon any such other suitable inscription or design as it
- 7 determines. If any town or city changes any design or inscription upon
- 8 its seal, a certificate describing such change shall be made and filed by
- 9 the town clerk of such town or city with the Secretary of the State. The
- 10 town clerk shall have the custody of such seal.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
