## AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING FOR NUTRITION ASSISTANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 17b-791 of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2025*):
- 3 (a) The Department of Social Services shall establish a supplemental
- 4 nutrition commodities assistance program to provide funds for the
- 5 purchase of <u>produce</u>, high protein <u>foods</u> or other nutritionally beneficial
- 6 supplemental foods [, or both,] for soup kitchens, food pantries and
- 7 emergency shelters. Such foods shall be purchased in bulk by [the
- 8 Connecticut Food Bank] Connecticut Foodshare through in-state
- 9 wholesalers or brokers, or both, and allotted to existing soup kitchens,
- 10 food pantries and emergency shelters in accordance with the established
- policies of [the Connecticut Food Bank] Connecticut Foodshare.
- 12 <u>(b) At least fifteen per cent of funds appropriated for the program</u>
- pursuant to section 2 of this act shall be used in each fiscal year to
- 14 purchase produce or other products from Connecticut farmers. Within
- 15 available appropriations, funds appropriated pursuant to section 2 of

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- this act shall be increased not less than three per cent each fiscal year
- 17 <u>beginning July 1, 2026</u>. Such soup kitchens, food pantries and
- 18 emergency shelters [shall pay] may be charged a handling [charge of]
- 19 <u>fee of up to</u> five cents per pound in order to cover the costs incurred by
- 20 [the Connecticut Food Bank] <u>Connecticut Foodshare</u>. The food shall be
- 21 distributed free of charge by the soup kitchens, food pantries and
- 22 emergency shelters.
- 23 Sec. 2. (Effective July 1, 2025) The sum of ten million dollars is
- 24 appropriated to the Department of Social Services from the General
- 25 Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026, for the supplemental
- 26 nutrition commodities assistance program established pursuant to
- section 17b-791 of the general statutes, as amended by this act.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
