**AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY ON TOURISM BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The joint standing committee of the  
2 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to commerce  
3 shall conduct a study relating to tourism and its effects and impact on  
4 the state and its economy. Not later than February 1, 2020, said  
5 committee shall submit a report of the results of such study in  
6 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
