AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY ON TOURISM BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The joint standing committee of the
- 2 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to commerce
- 3 shall conduct a study relating to tourism and its effects and impact on
- 4 the state and its economy. Not later than February 1, 2020, said
- 5 committee shall submit a report of the results of such study in
- 6 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following		
sections:

To require the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters related to commerce to study tourism and its effects and impact on the state and its economy.
