RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE CONSTITUTION TO PERMIT NO-EXCUSE ABSENTEE VOTING.

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That article sixth of the Constitution of the state be amended to
- 2 allow any qualified elector to cast an absentee ballot without needing
- 3 to satisfy a specific reason enumerated by law, rather than have to
- 4 appear at a polling place on the day of an election.

Statement of Purpose:

To eliminate the requirement that an elector satisfy a particular reason specified by law in order to cast an absentee ballot.
