RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE CONSTITUTION CONCERNING TERM LIMITS AND FINANCIAL INTERESTS.

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That the Constitution of the state be amended to provide that,
- 2 beginning with those officials elected at the state election in 2026, (1) no
- 3 person shall serve more than (A) eighteen years in the General
- 4 Assembly, or (B) twenty-four years in one or more constitutional state-
- 5 wide offices, and (2) in the case where the increase in any such elected
- 6 official's net worth is in excess of ten per cent per year while in office,
- 7 the amount of such excess shall be donated to a national charity in which
- 8 such elected official has no familial or financial interest.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish term limits for certain elected officials and provide for limits on increases to such officials' net worths while in office.
