RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE CONSTITUTION REQUIRING A TWO-THIRDS VOTE FOR LEGISLATIVE ENACTMENT OF NEW UNFUNDED MUNICIPAL MANDATES.

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That article third of the Constitution of the state be amended to
- 2 require the approval by a vote of not less than two-thirds of the
- 3 members of each house of the General Assembly to enact any new
- 4 municipal mandate for which no state reimbursement is provided to
- 5 municipalities for costs resulting from such mandate.

Statement of Purpose:

To require approval by a vote of not less than two-thirds of the members of each chamber of the General Assembly to enact a new unfunded state mandate.
