## RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE CONSTITUTION TO PERMIT THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ADDITIONAL TIME TO REVIEW AND CONSIDER CERTAIN JUDICIAL NOMINATIONS FROM THE GOVERNOR.

Resolved by this Assembly:

That article twenty-fifth of the amendments to the Constitution of the state be amended to provide that if the Governor has renominated a judge whose eight-year term is set to expire during the course of a regular session of the General Assembly, such eight-year term shall be extended for an additional period of time not to exceed thirty days to allow the General Assembly additional time to consider and review the nomination from the Governor.

## Statement of Purpose:

To permit the General Assembly additional time to review and consider certain judicial nominations from the Governor.
