**RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE
CONSTITUTION TO PERMIT THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ADDITIONAL
TIME TO REVIEW AND CONSIDER CERTAIN JUDICIAL
NOMINATIONS FROM THE GOVERNOR.**

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That article twenty-fifth of the amendments to the Constitution of
- 2 the state be amended to provide that if the Governor has renominated
- 3 a judge whose eight-year term is set to expire during the course of a
- 4 regular session of the General Assembly, such eight-year term shall be
- 5 extended for an additional period of time not to exceed thirty days to
- 6 allow the General Assembly additional time to consider and review
- 7 the nomination from the Governor.

Statement of Purpose:

To permit the General Assembly additional time to review and consider certain judicial nominations from the Governor.
