Resolution No. 94***

***RESOLUTION VACATING THE DECISIONS OF THE CLAIMS  
COMMISSIONER TO DISMISS THE CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE OF  
JUSTIN LUND AND SHAWN SAUNDERS AND AUTHORIZING THE  
CLAIMANTS TO SUE THE STATE.***

Resolved by this Assembly:

1 Section 1. That the decision of the Claims Commissioner, file  
2 number 24862 of said commissioner, ordering the dismissal of the  
3 claim against the state in excess of fifty thousand dollars of Justin  
4 Lund, is vacated and the claimant is authorized to institute and  
5 prosecute to final judgment an action against the state to recover  
6 damages as compensation for injury to person or damage to property,  
7 or both, allegedly suffered by the claimant as set forth in said claim.  
8 After reviewing the decision of the Claims Commissioner, in  
9 accordance with the provisions of subsection (c) of section 4-159 of the  
10 general statutes, the General Assembly deems authorization to  
11 institute and prosecute to final judgment such action against the state  
12 to be just and equitable and believes that the claimant, Justin Lund, has  
13 presented to the General Assembly issues of law and fact under which  
14 the state, were it a private person, could be liable. Such action shall be  
15 brought not later than one year from the date of the final adoption by  
16 the General Assembly of this resolution.

17 Sec. 2. That the decision of the Claims Commissioner, file number

18 25002 of said commissioner, ordering the dismissal of the claim against  
19 the state in excess of fifty thousand dollars of Shawn Saunders, is  
20 vacated and the claimant is authorized to institute and prosecute to  
21 final judgment an action against the state to recover damages as  
22 compensation for injury to person or damage to property, or both,  
23 allegedly suffered by the claimant as set forth in said claim. After  
24 reviewing the decision of the Claims Commissioner, in accordance  
25 with the provisions of subsection (c) of section 4-159 of the general  
26 statutes, the General Assembly deems authorization to institute and  
27 prosecute to final judgment such action against the state to be just and  
28 equitable and believes that the claimant, Shawn Saunders, has  
29 presented to the General Assembly issues of law and fact under which  
30 the state, were it a private person, could be liable. Such action shall be  
31 brought not later than one year from the date of the final adoption by  
32 the General Assembly of this resolution.
