AN ACT REQUIRING HOMEOWNERS INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THE PERIL OF COLLAPSE AND CERTAIN STRUCTURAL MITIGATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to require 2 homeowners insurance policies to provide coverage for: (1) The peril of 3 collapse; and (2) mitigation undertaken to prevent all or part of the
- 4 covered dwelling from falling down or caving in.

Statement of Purpose:

To require homeowners insurance policies to provide coverage for: (1) The peril of collapse; and (2) mitigation undertaken to prevent all or part of the covered dwelling from falling down or caving in.
