**AN ACT INCREASING INCOME AND ASSET LIMITS FOR THE
ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE RESPITE CARE PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 17b-349e of the general statutes be amended to expand
- 2 access to the Alzheimer's disease respite care program by increasing the
- 3 income eligibility cap to fifty-five thousand dollars and the liquid asset
- 4 eligibility cap to one hundred thirty-five thousand dollars.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the number of persons eligible for the Alzheimer's disease respite care program.
