AN ACT CONCERNING THE FEES AND CHARGES FOR AN EDUCATOR LICENSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That subsection (l) of section 10-145b of the general statutes be amended to eliminate any application review fees charged by the State Board of Education for an educator certificate license and to set the maximum amount the state board may charge for issuance of such

5 license at one hundred dollars.

Statement of Purpose:

To assist in the recruitment of teachers by lowering the cost of educator licensing fees and charges.
