AN ACT ESTABLISHING WOMEN'S ECONOMIC EQUALITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to establish economic equality 2 for women by: (1) Requiring paid family and medical leave; (2) 3 increasing the minimum wage to fifteen dollars per hour by 2021; (3) 4 extending required sexual harassment prevention training to 5 companies with fewer than twenty employees, and requiring all such training to be conducted annually regardless of the number of 6 7 employees; (4) requiring equal pay for equal work, establishing 8 standards for employees to prove unequal pay, establishing a 9 presumption that employers are in compliance with equal pay 10 standards if they conduct regular pay audits to ensure equal pay for 11 equal work; and (5) providing that each private and public employer 12 have a minimum of ten per cent of women on their board of directors 13 by 2021, and thirty per cent of women on such boards by 2023.
