## AN ACT ELIMINATING PUBLIC ASSISTANCE FOR RESIDENTS WHO ABANDON STATE RESIDENCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to (1) establish a
- 2 rebuttable presumption that persons absent from the state for more than
- 3 thirty days have abandoned state residency for the purpose of public
- 4 assistance, and (2) eliminate public assistance for such persons.

## Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit public assistance for persons who leave the state for more than thirty days.
