Substitute Bill No. 101

AN ACT CONCERNING WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS FOR INCARCERATED PERSONS AND PERSONS REENTERING THE COMMUNITY AFTER INCARCERATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Not later than October 1, 2022, the
2 Chief Workforce Officer, in consultation with the Commissioner of
3 Correction, shall develop a plan to expand the state's current workforce
4 development programming for incarcerated persons and persons
5 reentering the community after incarceration. Such plan shall include,
6 but need not be limited to, increasing the opportunities for such persons
7 to receive technological training to support such persons' reintegration
8 into the state workforce. Not later than January 1, 2023, the Chief
9 Workforce Officer shall implement such plan. Not later than January 1,
10 2024, the Chief Workforce Officer shall report, in accordance with the
11 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, regarding such plan
12 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
13 cognizance of matters relating to commerce.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
