## AN ACT ALLOWING POLICE OFFICERS TO WEAR RELIGIOUS HEAD COVERINGS AS PART OF A POLICE UNIFORM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective from passage) (a) As used in this section,
- 2 "law enforcement unit" and "police officer" have the same meanings as
- 3 provided in section 7-294a of the general statutes.
- 4 (b) Not later than October 1, 2022, each law enforcement unit shall
  - adopt or amend a policy to permit a police officer to wear a religious
- 6 head covering in accordance with the police officer's religious beliefs
- 7 while the police officer is on duty and wearing a uniform or other
- 8 authorized attire, except where the use of tight-fitting protective
- 9 headgear is required by such law enforcement unit.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
