Introduced by: SEN. SAMPSON, 16th Dist.

AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF PROHIBITING NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS THAT RECEIVE STATE FUNDING FROM ENGAGING IN CERTAIN POLITICAL OR PARTISAN ACTIVITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That a working group be established to study and recommend (1)
- 2 effective methods for prohibiting nonprofit organizations that receive
- 3 state funding, either directly or indirectly, from endorsing, opposing or
- 4 contributing to biased political ideologies, or engaging in partisan
- 5 campaign activities, (2) potential repercussions for a violation, including
- 6 the reduction or elimination of state funding or criminal liability, and
- 7 (3) an appropriate process for reviewing claims of such activity,
- 8 including the feasibility of requiring nonprofit organizations to
- 9 demonstrate that no state funds were used for such purposes.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a working group to study how to keep biased, partisan politics out of the nonprofit sector.
