**AN ACT CONCERNING ELECTORAL PRIVILEGES OF PAROLEES  
AND CERTAIN INCARCERATED INDIVIDUALS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 9 of the general statutes be amended to (1) permit all
- 2 future felony convicts committed to confinement in a correctional
- 3 institution or facility or a community residence to retain electoral
- 4 privileges, (2) restore such privileges to felony convicts presently so
- 5 confined, and (3) restore such privileges to felony convicts released
- 6 from such confinement but who may not have been discharged from
- 7 parole.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide for restoration of electoral privileges to parolees and  
individuals incarcerated as a result of felony convictions, and for  
retention of such privileges by individuals who may be so incarcerated  
in the future.
