AN ACT CONCERNING CONSUMER PRIVACY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) require businesses to
- 2 disclose the proposed use of any personal information, (2) give
- 3 consumers the right to discover what personal information such
- 4 business possesses and to opt out of the sale of such information, and
- 5 (3) create a cause of action and penalties for violations of such
- 6 requirements.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect consumer data privacy from unwanted sale and dissemination.
