AN ACT CODIFYING THE RULINGS OF CERTAIN UNITED STATES SUPREME COURT DECISIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to codify the holdings of (1)
- 2 Plyler v. Doe, 457 U.S. 202; (2) Griswold v. Connecticut, 381 U.S. 479; (3)
- 3 Miranda v. Arizona, 384 U.S. 436; and (4) Gideon v. Wainwright, 372
- 4 U.S. 335.

Statement of Purpose:

To preserve rights articulated by the United States Supreme Court for residents of this state, even if the court overturns its previous decisions.
