AN ACT CONCERNING THE REOPENING OF CONNECTICUT'S VISITOR WELCOME CENTERS USING VOLUNTEER STAFFING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-399 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Department of Economic and Community Development to create a
- 3 plan, in consultation with local chambers of commerce, to recruit local
- 4 volunteers to staff the state's visitor welcome centers and to reopen
- 5 any closed visitor welcome centers not later than July 1, 2019.

To encourage the opening and utilization of the state's visitor welcome centers.
